PAST THE POINT was bumped off stride at the start, moved up along the inside, pressed the pace for five furlongs, opened a clear advantage on the turn, extended his lead in upper stretch and held off the runner-up under steady right hand urging. TRUE RESURGENCE stumbled then bumped with the winner at the start, saved ground along the backstretch, rallied along the rail leaving the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain the place. SIGHTSEEING took up sharply along the rail while lacking room on the first turn, was unhurried for a half, bumped with FIT FAZE on the far turn, closed the gap while rallying along the rail at the quarter pole then lacked a strong closing bid. SMOKEYJONESSUTTON dueled outside the winner to the far turn and tired. KETCHIKAN steadied after being squeezed between horses at the start, checked on the first turn, stalked three wide to the turn and gradually tired thereafter. FIT FAZE was bumped a bit while well back on the far turn and lacked the needed response when called upon.
