IBBOYEE settled on the outside, was asked while three wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip while four wide into the stretch, responded well when switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker, closed fast on the outside late and got up at the wire. BE BULLISH stumbled badly at the start then bumped with NAUGHTY NEW YORKER, recovered fairly quickly, tracked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the turn, drew even while under urging passing the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. SIX FLINGS bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed in third position, chased while off the rail on the turn, came under a left-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, chased while under left hand urging in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. OVEREXTENDED settled while under some urging, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response while gaining some ground. MINESWEPT bumped with MR. WINDJAMMER at the start, was pulled off that rival, moved to the lead, set the pace while under a kind hold, came under pressure while inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost touch with BE BULLISH near the furlong marker and weakened. MR. WINDJAMMER was bumped on both sides at the start then taken up, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER lunged outward at the start, brushed the outside of the gate then bumped with BE BULLISH, settled on the outside while under some urging, was ridden along on the turn and also failed to respond.
