Footnotes

ARGENTINE TALISMAN settled into midpack after the start, bumped lightly with TOP SURPRIZE in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, was taken outward shortly thereafter, being placed four wide by midpoint on the turn, got called upon and rallied in earnest after entering the stretch, closed in to loom a serious threat with an eighth to go, bid between rivals from the sixteenth pole, poked a head in front and dug in with good determination to preserve the decision. SOUR raced off the inside, was urged five wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to procure the place. TOP SURPRIZE swung three wide into the backstretch, bumped lightly with the runner up soon after entering the second turn, unleashed a sweeping move to circle past rivals and take over the two path nearing the end of the far turn, was under encouragement going after the leader turning for home, kicked clear during the ensuing furlong, felt intense pressure a sixteenth down the road, yielded reluctantly. KID CURRY lightly bumped at the start, was content to race near the back of the

back, began to pick up interest departing the half mile pole, came from the five path into the stretch and displayed a good kick down the center of the course to secure the final major award. Z APPEAL tracked the pacesetter while racing towards the inside, cut the corner under encouragement, lacked the needed response. MISTER PIPPIT left the rail at the half mile pole, altered course outward coming to the three-sixteenths pole, improved position. IVY CONNECTION left alertly, chased the leader while placed in the two path, was taken in hand when in a little tight near the three-eighths pole, was asked for some run and made an abbreviated bid, flattened out upon reaching upper stretch. PUNSTER saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. IT DOESN'T ADD UP made light contact with KID CURRY at the break, but struck the front rapidly under his own power nonetheless, sparred with CHASING MOONLIGHT before edging away to a clear advantage nearing the first turn, cut the pace from the inside, was put to the test by TOP SURPRIZE nearing the end of the far turn, gave in to it during the run through the furlong grounds, and steadily tired thereafter. CHASING MOONLIGHT away alertly, sparred with IT DOESN'T ADD UP early, was shaken off, gave chase from the outside, folded.
