Footnotes

JOONBI came away in good order, raced just off the pace while behind rivals and under a snug hold, moved outside for clear room near the half-mile pole, ranged up while three to four wide on the turn, took the lead under brisk hand urging in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the eighth-pole, drifted in while dueling with MEDIA STARLETT, battled gamely with that rival to the wire and narrowly prevailed under continued right hand urging. MEDIA STARLETT dropped towards the inside early, was well placed just behind the leader, bided her time on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, advanced to make a bid in upper stretch, battled with JOONBI while under right hand urging and just missed in a game effort. CELTIC CHANT bumped the hindquarters of SANTORINI MOON after the start, was rank while behind rivals from nine-sixteenths pole to the half-mile pole, came under some urging while off the rail on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and got up for the show. EMILY ALLSTAR was ridden along while well off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside approaching the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. VICTORIA LYNN was hustled from the start, moved in while in front, set the pace, vied inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead, came under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. ALASKA MISS chased the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the turn, led into the stretch, came under the whip and tired. MY IRISH GIRL broke very awkwardly then dropped back, raced at the rear while on the outside, went four then three wide on the turn and was no factor. SANTORINI MOON was bumped in the hindquarters after the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the turn, came under the whip nearing the quarter-pole and failed to respond.
