**Footnotes**

JITNEY took the inside route, well reserved down the backstretch and around the bend as well, picked up interest heading for the stretch, angled outward lane by lane during the run through the furlong grounds, hand urged all the while and closing ground, was four wide by midstretch, continued onward, left the sixteenth pole with a full head of steam, rolled by the remaining front runners to take over in deep stretch, crossing the wire, hand urged. DRINKSONTHEHOUSE turned sideways just of the gate after being bumped at the hind quarters, tracked the loose leader towards the inside, was taken outward starting from the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch from the three path and got called upon, closed in readily on A., P. HUTCHY, with the winner joining in on the action by the eighth pole, never did gain the advantage, but finished the race with good energy to garner place honors. A. P. HUTCHY established control early down the backstretch, set the opening splits, from the rail and on an open lead, remained unasked for run until upper stretch, felt the presence of the top pair by the sixteenth pole, got reeled in by each in unison during the final seventy yards. CAPE COD CAROL out a step, was pulled off the nearest opponent before serious contact could be made, remained unhurried from off the inside in the opening stages, got set down soon after settling into upper stretch, altered course outward and came home with good belatedly foot en route for the last major check. BELLA SILVER gave chase from between rivals on the turn, was asked for a response by the five-sixteenths pole, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole before weakening. BRIDGETTA had no rally. IT'S YOUR DIME broke inward awkwardly, sat a loose pocket while tracking the pacesetter, came up empty for the stretch run. AZASECRET was taken hold after leaning on FUJIANA at the start, raced from off the inside and never reached contention. FUJIANA got bumped at the start, was under light urging from the get-go, advanced into contention while undergoing a three wide pursuit on the turn, entered the stretch having been put to a drive from the five-sixteenths pole, gave way.
