**Footnotes**

NEVER ON TIME broke out and bumped with CURRENT DESIGN, went to the front, was well rated on an easy lead, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under strong handling. NATIVE WAVE tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place while unable to reach the winner. BARRYMORE raced off the rail on the first turn, settled inside on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner in the final furlong and finished willingly to just get the show. SUNS OUT GUNS OUT saved ground on the first turn, settled near the inside, raced inside on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, angled out under a drive and again finished willingly but just missed the show. ZAJAL went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased in upper stretch, came under the whip near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. TWIGAZURI STRAIT was taken in hand immediately at the start, raced under a snug hold while into the bit along the rail, saved ground through the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SOUTHERN JOY was eager into the first turn then reserved while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn and failed to rally. CURRENT DESIGN was bumped at the start, settled towards the back while off the inside, was roused on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor. DAUNTING (IRE) lagged at the rear of the field, came under urging outside the half-mile pole, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten.
