HARRODS CREEK unhurried inside in midpack, bided time throughout, maneuvered to the two path at the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive approaching the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home, collared the embattled duo now on the front at the three-sixteenths seizing command at that station, drew clear under a drive before being geared down in the final strides while safely clear to prevail. TAHOE LAKE (BRZ) three wide in close range of the front, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, moved in tandem with the new leader through the turn, got displaced by the aforementioned rival at the three-sixteenths, battled on determined to the wire to win the battle for the place. HAILSTONE just off the inside in close range of the leader, seized the front at the seven-sixteenths, was immediately confronted by TAHOE LAKE and moved in concert with that rival through the turn matching strides, got displaced on the front by the eventual winner at the three-sixteenths, fought on to the wire having no answer for the top one while all out, proved not to have enough late on and was forced to settle for the show honors. GAME BALL towards the rear in the two path, progressed on the front urged along from the three-eighths pole, was four wide nearing the quarter pole when availing of the opportunity to slip in to the two path rather than circle wide at the top of the lane, angled out one path at the three-sixteenths for a clear run, kicked home to gain mildly late on while along for the last major share. INSCRUTABLE towards the rear saving ground throughout, offered no response when called upon at the five-sixteenths. BALLET BOY (IRE) marshaled the field while lightly held down along the inside, got headed at the seven-sixteenths, came under urging at the three-eighths in response and gave way.
