### Footnotes

SLAN ABHAILE showed good speed then tracked the pace on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, took a short lead inside the furlong marker, battled with GOOGLEADO into the final sixteenth, disposed of that rival at that point then held off the runner-up under strong handling. GOMBHEY DANCER dropped in before going a quarter mile, was hard ridden towards the inside, saved ground on the turn, came out at the top of the stretch and brushed with RATION, chased under the whip into the final furlong, pursued the winner into the final sixteenth, gained on that rival late and missed while able to secure the place. GOOGLEADO (ARG) broke out and bumped with an opponent, brushed with that same foe shortly thereafter, showed good speed and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip, lost the advantage inside the furlong marker, fought on into the final sixteenth then weakened while able to save the show. MIDNITE POPPA was void of early speed while hustled, eventually settled near the back while on the outside, dropped in near the half-mile pole, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted out some outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly but missed the show. RATION was coaxed along while just off the pace, went three wide early on the turn, was driven four wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, brushed with a rival after turning into the stretch and came out, pursued the vanguard under a drive and lacked the needed kick. INDIAN NOBILITY was bumped at the start then brushed with the same rival shortly thereafter, showed speed then chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole and tired. M P JOE broke about five to six lengths behind the rest of the field, raced at the rear while hard ridden, went three wide on the turn, angled six wide at the top of the stretch, drifted out under a left-handed whip shortly thereafter and was no factor. RINCON BEHR settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the turn and faded.
