TRUTH IS settled into midpack after the start, was unhurried for the first half of the event, got tipped into the three path and asked for some run coming to the five-sixteenths marker, spun into the lane within good striking distance, emerged from the furlong grounds as the new leader, stayed sufficiently in the clear under good handling. TIZ FOR TAT between rivals about a furlong down the road, traded light bumps with each of them during an abbreviated jostling match, darted over to the rail soon afterwards, cut the corner into the lane and made good progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, was taken hold and proceeded to alter course into the four path with an eighth to go, maintained the momentum after finishing the maneuver and came home with good energy en route for the place. POISON APPLE bumped lightly with STORMY HENRY at the start, got hooked up a duel with the same opponent, made it over to the rail by the end of the backstretch, arrived at the quarter pole still locked in combat but with the eventual winner now lurking a serious threat, yielded before the conclusion of the furlong grounds and steadily weakened. STORMY HENRY made light contact with POISON APPLE as the field was sent on its way, got engaged in a protracted duel with the same foe, fought for the lead from the outside, kept up that pursuit until midstretch before backing away. ARRIVING exchanged a series of light bumps with the runner up about an eighth after the start, being one of three in close quarters to each other at that stage, sat within range off the contested pace from the two path around the bend, failed to fire appreciably when set down for the drive. FRAME off slowly after breaking awkwardly, took the inside route, was under solid encouragement leaving the three-eighths pole, commenced to angle outward a sixteenth later, fanned wider and wider until in the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed closing response. PAZOLINI was the third member of a jostling incident in the initial stages, raced three wide, was under a drive prior to the quarter pole, gave way. BELLAMY CHIEF displayed greenness during the opening furlong, twice requiring the pilot to take a good hold on the reins, was never in contention off the subsequent ground-saving journey. IN THE DARK three wide entering the turn was in the four path exiting it, got outrun.
