Footnotes

QUANTITY unhurried in midpack while being primarily two wide, picked up interest after completing six furlongs, entered the stretch and began to close in on the front runners, altered course a couple of paths to the outside in midstretch, settled into his best stride, and surged by the runner up in the final stages

to take over, edged away, crossing the wire under hand urging. WISHINGONADREAM came away alertly and established control before reaching the first turn, raced towards the inside, being rated along while cutting the pace on a loosely-contested lead, got turned loose at the top of the lane just as the pressure was building up, remained with none latched on racing through the furlong grounds, proved powerless to stave off the winner's strong kick, but dug in gamely to preserve the place. EAST OF DANZIG lunged at the start, raced from off the inside, got tipped into the three path leaving the backstretch, drafted behind KANGAROO, followed the same foe one path wider at the three-sixteenths pole, was yet one path wider by the head of the stretch, got straightened away and mustered up a solid closing response en route for the show. LURE OF THE SOUTH off the inside, partnered up with SPRINGCOURT, got fanned six to seven wide into upper stretch, had a good finish down the outside of the course with only the last major check to show for it. FORMULAFORSUCCESS tracked the pacesetter from the pocket, was asked for run intermittently while drafting behind that opponent down the lane. SAM'S BUCK rode the rail to the five-sixteenths marker, was asked for a response angling out at that juncture, commenced the stretch three wide, scurried into a strong contending position with a furlong remaining, couldn't sustain the run and steadily backed away. PERFECT FOOTPRINT at or near the inside, failed to menace. KANAGARO underwent a three to four wide journey, had no rally. SPRINGCOURT saved ground until the quarter pole, wandered towards the middle of the course travelling through the furlong grounds, made no impact. DUAL CITIZEN bobbed at the start, moved up to assume of primary pursuer, prompted the second place finisher from the outside until upper stretch then gave way. LOUIE MONDELLO lunged out a bit awkwardly taking his first step out of the starting gate, raced between rivals for a good portion of the opening three-quarters, was given his cue and angled outward nearing the quarter pole, made no headway. PERFECT JOISKI forwardly placed three wide, stopped abruptly after completing six furlongs.
