Footnotes

KATE IS A TEN went two to three wide on the first turn, settled nicely in fourth position, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, made a bid on the outside near the three-sixteenths, battled three abreast in the final furlong and proved best under strong urging. EDDY'S TIME raced off the rail on the first turn, was well placed in third position behind the clear duo, ranged up while three to four wide on the far turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while just able to get the place. DONE SMOKING was taken back early then angled to the inside, raced at the rear while unhurried, moved up along the rail late on the backstretch, advanced past several rivals, came off the rail at the five-sixteenths, shifted three wide nearing the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid between rivals, battled between those opponents into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. CHRISSY GIRL broke out at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear, moved out near the half-mile pole, went four wide early on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail before the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, advanced into a good striking position, chased in the final furlong and was outkicked. RAVEN RISE saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced inside early on the far turn then came off the rail, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, was put to a drive into the stretch, advanced into the final furlong but flattened out. LET ME BE NUTS raced off the rail on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, settled on the outside, was roused while four wide on the far turn, advanced in upper stretch but also flattened out. RESOLUTELY settled while off the inside, dropped to the rail midway through the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to rally. LEFT UPPERCUT was hustled from the start, set the pace through solid fractions, vied a bit off the rail on the far turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, was in tight while dropping back at the top of the stretch and gave way. CAROLE LEE went two to three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, chased two to three wide early on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. WILD FRANCES

raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, faltered on the far turn, dropped to the rear and was pulled up then walked off. (Rail at 18 Feet)
