GIMME CREDIT reserved from off the inside, swung six wide into the stretch, took off with good energy after getting straightened away, showed gameness to outfinish a pair to get up near the shadow of the wire. SUNLOVER patiently tracked from the inside, altered course with a furlong to go, came home willingly en route for the place. HIDDEN VOW broke inward, tucked along he rail before reaching the end of the homestretch, contently tracked the front runners remaining along the inside route, responded positively when given his cue for the drive, launched a rail rally successful enough to hold the narrowest of leads for about a jump or two, got overtaken shortly afterwards and had to settle for the show. TYCOON CAT contested the lead from the outside, moved when ready leaving the five-sixteenths pole to lead the field into the stretch by a slim margin, lengthened away from upper to midstretch, got reeled in belatedly. BARNARDS GALAXY hit the right side of the starting gate, was strung out three wide on the opening bend and remained off the rail

throughout, mustered up a mild response good enough for minor spoils. ARCHER HILL bumped at the start, was three wide entering the far turn and five wide leaving it, lacked the needed response. PAPA FREUD broke to the inside, making contact with the nearest opponent, chased the front runners three wide on the second bend, gave way. NORTHERN TRIPP carried in at the start, was sluggish in the early going, failed to reach a contending position. JAMES JINGLE along the rail on the far turn, failed to menace. CAPTAIN DAVRICK tracked the leader from the pocket and faltered. SEAL TEAM FOUR argued to hold on to a narrow lead for three-quarters from the inside, relinquished before the head of the stretch and steadily retreated.
