PERSONAL FIRST showed good speed along the inside, responded when roused in upper stretch and drew clear under a drive. DISCO RICO quickly showed in front, set a strong pace while away from the inside rail and continued on gamely to the finish. TRIPPI raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. WAKE AT NOON was unprepared for the start, broke in the air, had his rider lose an iron after the start, put in a three wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. B L'S APPEAL raced inside and had no response when roused. TWILIGHT TIME had no rally, steadied in the stretch and tired.
