Footnotes

BURLETTA raced well in hand along the inside, checked while patiently waiting for room on the turn, slipped through along the inside to challenge in upper stretch then edged away in the final eighth. GRIFFIN CAT checked while being pinched back at the start, trailed along the backstretch, swung out on the turn, circled seven wide into the stretch then closed strongly in the middle of the track to gain the place. GILDED THREAD was outrun early, angled to the inside along the backstretch, gradually gained while saving ground on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and rallied mildly to gain a share. PRINCESS LANGFUHR bumped after breaking slowly, raced in the middle of the pack, swung five wide at the quarter pole and rallied mildly. MY OWN STORY stumbled at the start, sprinted clear early, set the pace along the inside into midstretch and weakened from her early efforts. PREACHER'S TALE reserved early, rallied four wide to reach contention on the turn then flattened out in the stretch. DREAMSTUFF settled just off the early pace, rallied three wide to threaten at the quarter pole but couldn't sustain her bid. LITETHENIGHT steadied in traffic along the backstretch and nearing the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. FAIR MAIDEN showed speed while in traffic at the half mile pole, dropped back on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. SMOKE GRANTED was outrun early, steadied in traffic on the first turn, circled six wide entering the stretch and failed to menace. HOLLYWOOD TALE bumped at the start, steadied at the half mile pole and gave way on the turn.
