Footnotes

DREAM RUSH sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead while saving ground, extended her advantage on the turn, opened a wide gap in midstretch then remained clear under steady right hand urging. BOCA GRANDE was outrun for a half, launched a rally between horses in the three path on the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch and finished full of run in the middle of the track to narrowly gain the place. BARONESS THATCHER settled just off the pace for a half, gradually gained three wide on the turn, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch, raced closest to the winner into deep stretch and was nipped for the place in the final strides. SHEETS prompted the pace in the two path to the top of the stretch and weakened from her early efforts. HIGH AGAIN was outrun to the turn and failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. AKRONISM raced up close along the rail, steadied along the inside on the backstretch, raced just off the pace while saving ground to the top of the stretch and gradually tired thereafter. DEBBIE GOT EVEN checked at the start, was outrun for a half, advanced five wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. SILVER KNOCKERS steadied sharply and

angled out for room along the backstretch, raced in midpack to the turn, angled six wide at the quarter pole and tired in the stretch. ASTOR PARK checked in traffic along the inside early, saved ground to the turn then gave way. COTTON BLOSSOM failed to mount a serious rally while five wide throughout. DOWN was outrun for a half after breaking slowly and never reached contention. TIME'S MISTRESS raced wide throughout.
