Footnotes

UNDER SERVICED sprinted clear in the early stages, dug in when challenged on the turn, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch then turned back several challengers while edging away under good handling. TWISTAWAY was reserved early, slipped through along the rail entering the stretch, made a run inside the winner to challenge inside the furlong marker but was no match for that one while holding for the place. CASEY'S TRIBE steadied briefly at the half mile pole, angled in on the turn, split rivals while gaining in midstretch and finished willingly. WESTERN SWEEP angled in on the backstretch, trailed for a half, swung five wide at the quarter pole then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. SAY TOBA SANDY was fractious behind the gate prior to the start, raced up close between horses into midstretch and tired. REYANA'S JET steadied along the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. LET'S FLY AWAY lodged a four wide move to challenge nearing the quarter pole and flattened out. SALT CITY MISS steadied along the rail on the backstretch, saved ground to the turn and faded in the stretch.
