SKIPADATE was rated in the two path for a half, advanced between horses on the turn, swung five wide for room at the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track to get up in the final stride to dead heat with NINTH CLIENT for the win. NINTH CLIENT dueled along the inside into upper stretch, briefly relinquished the lead in midstretch, battled back to reclaim a slim advantage in deep stretch and just lasted in a tight finish. LIME RICKEY was under a firm hold for a good part of the way, rallied inside leaving the turn, surged to the front in midstretch then weakened late. PIONEEROF THE NILE saved ground most of the way, split horses in upper stretch then finished willingly along the rail in the late stages. SEATTLE BREW steadied slightly nearing the first turn, settled in the three path, swung out on the turn and finished evenly. SNEAK PEEK pressed the pace from outside to the top of the stretch and tired. DA GULLAH steadied along the rail on the first turn, angled four wide while launching a brief bid on the turn and flattened out. MORAL was outrun while drifting out at the top of the stretch. INDY EXPRESS raced inside for five furlongs and gave way.
