Footnotes

WESLEY tucked in early, was unhurried for a half while saving ground, moved out on the far turn, split rivals midway on the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole and closed steadily to get up in the final strides. THOU SWELL sprinted clear along the inside, set the pace in hand, extended his lead along the backstretch, set the pace into upper stretch, dug in when challenged in midstretch, continued on the front into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. DEAL MAKING was under a firm hold while saving ground, awaited room along the rail midway on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, steadied while caught in traffic between horses inside the furlong mark, bumped with PICOU in deep stretch and rallied belatedly. ADRIANO tucked in along the rail was reserved for five furlongs, raced in hand along the inside on the turn, angled three wide in upper stretch, raced behind a wall of horses in midstretch, steadied while trapped behind horses through the final sixteenth and rallied belatedly after getting clear in deep stretch. FIELD SPORT stalked three wide to the turn, lodged a mild bid to threaten in midstretch and weakened late. PICOU raced between horses for five furlongs, angled 6wide at the top of the stretch then was bumped off stride while gaining in deep stretch. WILLSBORO POINT pressed the pace between horses into upper stretch, lodged a mild bid in midstretch and gave way.
