CONVOCAION was last away then asked a bit from the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, inched closer while three then two wide on the far turn, drew even with GLENWOOD CANYON and was roused nearing the quarter-pole, battled gamely with that rival while in close quarters in the stretch and narrowly prevailed while being flagged with the whip late. GLENWOOD CANYON was hustled from the start then well rated on the inside, came under a ride nearing the quarter-pole, battled gamely with CONVOCAION while in close quarters in the stretch and was denied while well clear for the place. ODDS ON (BRZ) raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while three wide on the far turn, could not go with the top two but gamely outfinished MIDNIGHT MISCHIEF for the show. MIDNIGHT MISCHIEF settled on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, moved around RETRIEVER near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to the rail leaving the far turn and failed to respond then just missed the show. OVERBID moved in to save ground on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. RETRIEVER tracked the pace while off the rail, came up empty on the far turn and stopped then was not urged late.
