**Footnotes**

DOMINUS came inward slightly and made some contact with STAR HARBOUR at the start, assumed a forward position and was the outermost of three vying for the lead, doing so from the three path, shook off, together with BERNIE THE MAESTRO, STAR HARBOUR during the later stages of the run around the bend, entered the stretch and got asked for a response, emerged from the furlong grounds with none latched on, extended the margin the final furlong despite drifting outward, crossing the wire, under hand urging, but not of the vigorous type. OUR DARK KNIGHT was outrun in the opening stages, while racing from off the rail, had already felt the whip spinning from the two path into the stretch, went his way through the furlong grounds before altering course to be outside all front runners, came home with good energy to get up in time for the place. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL unhurried from the outside for nearly a half, swung five wide into the stretch under encouragement, finished well, but missed out on place honors. WISHFUL TOMCAT out a couple of steps at the break, was grabbed hold, settled into midpack before reaching the end of the backstretch, came four wide into upper stretch already asked for run, was between rivals from upper stretch until the sixteenth pole en route to grabbing the final major slice of the pot. INFLATION TARGET took the inside route, was under a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, closed in well from that point until midstretch before flattening out. PHILIPPE chased the embattled trio for just over a half, came up empty when called upon. JUNEBUGRED three wide departing the backstretch, was outrun. BERNIE THE MAESTRO disputed the pace from between opponents until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, remained in a tussle with the eventual winner until mid lane, then weakened. STAR HARBOUR bumped at the start, went on to grab a narrow advantage, tucked along the inside, did battle with another pair until the five-sixteenths pole, fell back even though put to some urging, retreated.
