**Footnotes**

BALANCE THE BUDGET was well placed on the inside, came off the rail leaving the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, drove three wide while between rivals, took the lead inside the quarter-pole, edged clear under the whip in upper stretch and held under good handling. NOT TODAY raced toward the back on the first turn, dropped to the inside late on that bend, moved up with a half-mile to run, advanced inside on the far turn, waited outside the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, came between rivals, pursued the winner in the final furlong and finished willingly to just get the place. TRUMAN'S COMMANDER was reserved on the inside, came off the rail leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn, waited patiently outside the quarter-pole, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, came between rivals and also finished willingly but just missed the place. OUT OF YOUR MIND tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, pursued the winner into the final furlong and tired. LOVE MAN

was taken back early, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, came under urging on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. EL CORRIENTE was asked from the start, went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four to five wide on the far turn and gave way. HAPPY HIGH was in tight off heels early on the first turn then bumped lightly with MR. HOPPS, was reserved off the pace, raced outside on the backstretch, was in a bit tight entering the far turn and failed to rally. MANACOR (IRE) went to the front while inside on the first turn, set the pace through reasonable fractions, vied off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch, lost the lead to the winner and capitulated. MORE REUBENS was reserved under a snug hold while off the inside, came under urging on the far turn and was no factor. MR. HOPPS was bumped lightly in the hindquarters early on the first turn, went three to four wide on that turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and came up empty.
