Footnotes

TRITAP showed good speed, contested the pace on the inside, vied inside on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, dueled with CAPE GLORY in the final furlong and gamely prevailed. CAPE GLORY prompted the pace on the outside, vied three wide while urged along on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, battled gamely with TRITAP in the final furlong and just missed. JOKING was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn, was asked for more in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, angled five wide approaching the five-sixteenths, rallied under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, closed well on the outside, loomed a threat in the final furlong but was unable to overtake the top two while finishing willingly for the show. D'TIGER bobbled at the start, was rated just off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, came under left-handed encouragement in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, was switched to a right-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. IN SPEIGHT OFITALL threw his head at the start, settled at the rear, raced five wide into the turn then dropped to one off the inside, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and improved position. CHIEF GAGA bobbled outward after the start then was taken up by the rider, raced towards the inside while under some urging, saved ground on the turn, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, continued under strong right hand urging in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DATTTT HAPPY disputed the pace on the outside, vied between rivals on the turn, dropped out in upper stretch and gave way. GUILT TRIP settled off the pace while under some urging, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and also lacked the needed response. AVARICE was rated just off the pace, drafted behind the leaders while off the rail on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and failed to rally. STARTER was in a tad tight between rivals early, raced on the outside while ridden along, went four wide early on the turn, moved to six wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back to four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. GRAND RAPIDS was last away then drifted out at the rear, settled towards the back, moved out leaving the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
