FORTIFY acted up in the gate before the field was sent off and running, came away with no apparent mishap, contently stalked the early pacesetter from off the inside, crept up to draw alongside upon reaching the turn, took over and edged away, responded positively when given his cue in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds holding a decisive margin and maintained it. EL DURO came inward slightly at the start, was grabbed hold and kept from making any contact with the nearest rival at the time., departed the backstretch from the four path, remained well off the inside on the turn, drifted out slightly in mid lane, proved no match for the winner while clear of the others for the place. UNLIKELY SCENARIO three wide at the half mile pole, made a bid late on the turn, lost contact with the top one after entering the stretch and tired. CHANNEL ISLE came in slightly at the start, was slow to settle into stride, picked up the pace noticeably from the seven-sixteenths pole, improved position belatedly by weak and tired ones. TRACK ROCKER saved ground to no avail. HORSE FELDHAUS three to four wide on the turn, was no factor. REVELATIONIST raced along the outside and tired. BOSS MAN ROCKET argued for control from the inside for nearly a half before fading.
