CRAVING CARATS quickly established control and was guided over to the inside, had a well strung out field contract somewhat after getting away with a softer second split, sailed along on the far turn, uncontested, entered the stretch and was soon called upon, held his ground well during the ensuing furlong, saw the margin cut down substantially in the last eighth, but reached the wire safely. BALANCE THE BOOKS bumped lightly with PAGE MCKENNEY at the start, sat reserved at the back of the pack for over a half, picked up interest upon reaching the far turn, was three wide departing the backstretch, then four wide by the five-sixteenths pole, displayed good energy down the center of the course en route for the place. SUMMER SHINER stalked the winner from afar from off the inside, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole to keep pace, held on well to the end to secure the show. FREDERICKSBURG tossed his head from side to side just prior to being sprung forth from the starting gate, left it lunging as a result, brought up the rear until the half mile pole, took the three path for most of the way around the second turn, was under a drive entering the stretch, tipped one more outward shortly afterwards, finished willingly to earn the last major check. SOULSINGING chased the loose leader from the outside, had no rally. WINNING CAUSE leaned upon by EQUUS PRIME for several strides after the break, was carried inward slightly then pulled away from the aforementioned to escape the unwanted early attention, took up residence in midpack, left the five-sixteenths pole from the three path, weakened in the final furlong. EQUUS PRIME saved ground and was no

menace. MATAGOT in tight quarters, was steadied just before reaching the end of the homestretch, took the inside route until the stretch run, was taken outward until six wide in the furlong grounds, made no impact. PAGE MCKENNEY came inward leaving the gate, initiating light contact with the runner up, never made it past midpack and tired. DENN PIPER faded off a ground-saving journey.
