TRICKY HAT (CHI) bumped lightly with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, came off the inside leaving the bend, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased two to three wide on the far turn, came under the whip at the quarter-pole, pursued the pacesetter under a left-handed whip into the final furlong, gained the lead leaving the sixteenth-pole and proved best while drifting out a tad under continued left-handed encouragement. SHARE OUT went three then two wide on the first turn, moved clear late on that bend, was well rated on a solo lead, came under urging near the quarter-pole, was given two cracks of a left-handed whip after turning into the stretch, switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. BELL BY THE RIDGE bumped lightly with an opponent early, settled on the inside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, was ridden along while close to the inside on the far turn, came out a bit at the top of the stretch, chased under a drive, rubbed saddles with TAHOE LAKE inside the furlong marker and finished willingly to just get the show. TAHOE LAKE (BRZ) went three then two wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three to four wide on the far turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch, rubbed saddles with BELL BY THE RIDGE inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick then missed the show. FILM MAKING came out and bumped lightly with a rival at the start, bumped lightly with BELL BY THE RIDGE early, settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, was asked for his best and finished with good courage but missed the superfecta. MAJESTIC RAFFY bumped solidly with GO ON MURT at the start, settled on the outside, went three to four wide early on the far turn, was driven five wide outside the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. GO ON MURT (IRE) was grabbed immediately at the start then bumped solidly with MAJESTIC RAFFY, raced under a very tight hold while rank for the opening half-mile, was reserved while still under restraint, went two to three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths and failed to

respond. ZANE was a bit rank while under restraint early, went three to four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, went four to five wide on the far turn, dropped back coming to the quarter-pole and faded. (Rail at 18 Feet)
