Footnotes

LA REINE BOURBON was taken back nearing the first turn then tucked into the two path, raced in third position while under some restraint, moved closer while inside early on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the inside at the top of the stretch while under mild encouragement, dropped back in shortly thereafter, rallied along the rail under strong hand urging, closed well to strike through the front outside the sixteenth-pole, remained under strong hand urging into the final sixteenth then was eased up late in a good debut. KETEL TWIST showed early speed, was rank while fighting the restraint of the rider through the first turn, settled more kindly before the five-eighths pole, tracked the leader on the outside, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, chased into upper stretch, made a bid while under a right-handed whip, held a narrow advantage into the final furlong, lost the lead to the winner and proved no match while clear for the place. ACQUANT went to the front, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked late on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead near the furlong marker and weakened while able to secure the show. DANCE TAP dropped back after the start, fell well behind while a bit sluggish, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field while off the inside on the backstretch, came under urging before the half-mile pole, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, gained ground to reach a reasonable striking position but flattened out. FIERCE BOOTS lunged at the start then bobbled a bit, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along at the half-mile pole, went three then two wide on the far turn and failed to rally. TEMPERS FLAIR was reserved on the inside, came under encouragement near the half-mile pole, saved ground through the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 18 Feet)
