Footnotes

BUG JUICE was away alertly from the outside post, quickly moved clear without the need of encouragement, controlled the action on an easy lead while off the inside, moved a bit closer to the rail to discourage ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS from coming through late on the backstretch, dictated terms while off the rail through the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch, remained clear into the final furlong, drifted out briefly under left-hand urging nearing the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider and held under good handling. BAKE SHOP hit the gate at the start and was off two to three lengths slow, moved up while coaxed along, was urged along while four to five wide on the turn, pursued the winner under the whip into the final furlong and closed well late to just miss. ZIVO was restless in the gate, exchanged bumps with JUNIOR OFFICER after the start, bumped also with DEHERE OF THE CAT at that stage, settled off the pace, went five wide early on the turn then dropped to three wide, came under the whip near the quarter-pole, dropped inward near the furlong marker, rallied one off the inside and finished well but missed. ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS settled in the second flight, moved up near the half-mile pole, tried to sneak through inside the winner at that point, dropped back after being tightened up a bit, shifted three wide midway through the turn, came under a drive, continued three wide into the stretch, chased the winner under the whip and finished willingly but missed the trifecta. QUIET POWER settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong and gained some ground but lacked the needed kick. DEHERE OF THE CAT bumped with ZIVO after the start, was urged along while off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch and gained some ground but failed to seriously threaten. COUSIN MICHAEL settled outside in the second flight, moved closer near the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the turn, continued four wide into the

stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. PAPA TOM settled at the rear of the field, drifted out near the half-mile pole, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. JUNIOR OFFICER exchanged bumps with ZIVO after the start, settled off the pace, dropped to the rail near the half-mile pole, saved ground on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and was no factor.
