Footnotes

FUNNY MONEY sat reserved from off the inside until the end of the backstretch, had HURRICANE JACKIE vacate the three path at that juncture, was let out a notch and scurried into contention, hitched up to the pacesetter as the third split was being recorded, entered the stretch and got asked for her best, gave it, taking charge shortly afterwards, edged away to her biggest advantage by the eighth pole, had the runner up close in well enough to loom a danger with slightly less than a sixteenth to go, came out a bit but dug in under good handling to fend that rival off. SATIN SHEEKS broke a couple of steps to the outside, had the pilot take a good hold on the left side and pull the mount away to make sure no contact could be made, raced primarily two wide on the opening bend, found refuge and settled along the inside route midway down the backstretch, remained along it bidding time until past the five-sixteenths marker, slipped back into the two path a few strides before arriving at the quarter pole, was kept on hold, idling along in upper stretch, awaiting optimal racing clearance, gained it and after altering course slightly to the outside commenced her rally, shied a bit wider reacting to the winner's slight movement in the same direction in deep stretch, continued on with good energy but had to settle for the place. MIZ OWELL at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, was three wide entering the second bend and in the four path exiting it, displayed a good kick down the center of the course en route for the

show. CENTRINA swung three wide into the backstretch, left the five-sixteenths pole one path wider, then was yet another path wider by the head of stretch, showed good late foot to take the last major check. GOLDEN CHEETAH saved ground for just over three-quarters, angled to the outside and eventually into being four wide by the end of the move, lacked a solid late closing response. MOONLIT SONNET put to some hand urging after leaving the starting gate, had the rider change tactics once EUROKAY BY ME secured a prominent position herself, vied to hold on to the advantage from the inside, had top one take up the role of primary pursuer coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was let out in response to the challenge, yielded while racing through the furlong grounds and gave way. BOURBON TWIST rode the rail on the opening bend, got tipped to the outside shortly after departing it, arrived at the five-sixteenths pole having been placed in the three path, had no rally. EUROKAY BY ME prompted the leader from the outside for six furlongs, folded. NECESSARY LUXURY raced along the outside and tired. RENNINA tracked the front runners from the pocket, was through after completing three-quarters. HURRICANE JACKIE forwardly placed three wide until the three-eighths pole, gave way.
