COUNTRY BE GOLD was urged along early on, rallied five wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely and drew clear under a drive. PANNER raced inside into the stretch, altered course in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. GILDED EMPEROR raced close up inside, had a clear trip along the rail and finished well. KRIS B was hustled outside, rallied four wide on the turn and faded in the final furlong. SCOUTING REPORT chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. FESTIVAL OF LIGHT contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. EMERGING FORCE tired after a four wide trip. ALEG contested the pace from the outside and tired.
