REUNITED contested the pace from the outside, drew clear on the turn, widened when roused and was kept to the task to the finish. BROADWAY GOLD was outrun early, raced inside and rallied to get the place prize. FACTUAL CONTENDER raced three wide and lacked a rally. INTENSE DESIRE chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. BUCK MOUNTAIN was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. EXIT TO HEAVEN chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. NEVAEH raced wide and had no response when roused. BOJANGLE'S CAT raced between rivals and tired after a half mile. FLEET INDIAN broke slowly and trailed throughout.
