**Footnotes**

RED ZIPPER dueled early along the rail, eased back slightly after going a half, angled out to launch his bid on the turn, battled into deep stretch and prevailed after a long drive. CONRAD CROSSING was outrun for five furlongs, advanced four wide into the stretch then finished well to gain the place. BAGAVOND dueled for the lead into deep stretch and checked while yielding near the wire. READY ENOUGH raced far back for six furlongs, split rivals in upper stretch and raced in traffic while gaining in deep stretch. YANKEE THUNDER pinched back at the start, checked in the early stages, trailed to the turn and rallied belatedly. AWARD SEATS saved ground early, waited in traffic on the far turn, saved ground to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. NOT ON MY TURF failed to mount a serious rally while three wide. STORM N LIGHTNING steadied along the rail on the first turn, raced up close while saving ground to the turn and tired. FUNNY CONNECTION was never a serious threat. PRINCE BILLY steadied on the first turn, raced three wide for five furlongs and gave way.
