**Footnotes**

BIG PRAIRIE was outrun while tucked in behind horses along the rail for a mile, waited patiently while saving ground leaving the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to win going away. OPERATION RED DAWN stumbled at the start, raced in the middle of the pack for seven furlongs, closed the gap from outside on the turn, made a strong move to challenge a sixteenth out but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. STUDENT COUNCIL settled just behind the dueling pacesetters, launched a rally three wide while gaining on the turn, surged to the front nearing the furlong marker, led to the sixteenth pole and weakened. ONE STARRY NITE pressed the pace through brisk fractions, opened a clear lead on the far turn, continued on the front into midstretch and weakened from his early efforts. PREP SCHOOL failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground. TAKEN NOT GIVEN was pinched back at the start after breaking slowly, raced well back along the backstretch, swung wide leaving the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. EMOTRIN steadily worked his way forward on the turn, angled four wide entering the stretch and finished evenly. ABOVE SPIRIT never reached contention. SINGLE MON checked after breaking inward, saved ground early and faded leaving the far turn. KID CAROUSEL was used up dueling through brisk fractions.
