GOOD CARD was reserved early, swung out to launch his bid on the turn, circled six wide while rapidly gaining entering the stretch then unleashed a strong late run to win going away. MAKIN ME FAMOUS stalked four wide early, made a move to challenge on the turn, led into upper stretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late rally. STOLEN FOREST saved ground just off the pace to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. TRICKANOMETRY stumbled at the start, trailed to the turn and never reached contention while five wide. YEAH MON failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. FRONTIER SKY steadied after breaking outward at the start, saved ground to the turn and lacked a late response. ESTIMATOR broke slowly, steadied in traffic on the far turn, swung wide at the quarter pole and lacked a late bid. MR ZIP pressed early between horses, steadied in traffic on the far turn and was never close thereafter. FERNANDO RUNS IT dueled along the rail into upper stretch and gave way. RADIO FREQ stumbled at the start chased three wide between horses for a half and faltered.
