(Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Preference by condition eligibility. Ties broken by total earnings. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. ENDLESS CIRCLE away alertly from the gate, was engaged in an early pace skirmish with DRIVEN BY SUCCESS during the opening portion of the run down the backstretch, shook free, working his way into the two path, once sufficiently clear, motored around the turn still well clear of the main rival, lengthened the advantage after turning for home, then increased the winning margin while being ridden out. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS moved up under mild encouragement to go head to head with the top one shortly after the start, swung into the three path after being rebuffed, resumed the chase, failed to keep up after entering the lane, but continued on willingly to earn the place. LEGAL CONSENT four wide around the turn, proved no match for the two pair during the stretch run, but mustered enough of a kick to be along for the show, then was vanned off after the finish. LAW ENFORCEMENT outrun for the initial half, while three wide, took the widest route of all heading for the stretch, settling into about the six path, displayed a mild rally to improve position past mainly weak and tired ones. MOR CHANCES forwardly placed, was urged along to keep pace with the front runners, backed off after completing a half. NAUGHTY NEW YORKER was never involved.
