Preference By Condition Eligibility. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Friday, July 30, 2010, with 18 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and OneHalf Furlongs on the main track.).

Footnotes

BRIDGETOWN patiently handled three wide during the initial stages, cruised up to the front runners when ready, with the rider still keeping something in reserve, was put to hand urging after turning for home, struck the front by the time he reached the eighth pole, then edged clear while remaining under hand encouragement. FLAMIN' HOT taken hold of early, remained unhurried and under a good hold entering the turn, was fanned five wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after being called upon, closed with good energy down the center of the course to garner place honors. RED RALLY broke alertly to grab command, set the fractions from the two path while being lightly coaxed along, was asked for more with a host of rivals gearing up for the stretch drive, stubbornly fended off the top one during the run through the furlong grounds, reluctantly yielded with an eighth to go, but continued on well to secure the show. NEVER CONTENT nicely positioned tracking the leader from the inside under a firm, lost some momentum when forced to check nearing the quarter pole, got back going again after entering the stretch, but lacked the necessary stretch response for the final furlong. WESTOVER WILDCAT raced off the inside, was steadied while in a bit tight at the seven-sixteenths pole, continued to pursue the leader on the turn, stumbled badly after appearing to clip the heels of DON'T SAY NO, approaching the quarter pole, had no serious offering thereafter. ENUMERATE lacked the needed bid. ESCROW KID reserved along the outside, fanned four wide into lane, but had no solid closing kick. DON'T SAY NO chased the leader from the get go, was roused at the five-sixteenths pole and faded. DAZZLED SAINT under a good hold towards the back of the pack, entered the stretch behind a wall of rivals, had no rally.
