Footnotes

MY DUE PROCESS contested the pace on the outside, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, kicked clear in upper stretch and drew off under a strong drive. INNY MINNIE was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while two then three wide on the turn, was put to the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, came under an all out drive in upper stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. GOLDEN ROCK was hustled from the start then urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail while under a right-handed whip at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. DOROTHY'S SPIRIT bumped with rivals at the start then dropped back, was reserved towards the rear, went two then three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive and improved position in the center of the course. SISTERHOOD bobbed at the start, settled off the pace while off the inside, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip around the furlong marker and failed to rally. DIXIE DARLING bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved near the back while under a tight hold, became rank off heels near the seven-sixteenths pole, waited near the back while inside on the turn, was asked while off the inside coming to the three-sixteenths pole, moved to the rail outside the sixteenth-pole and also failed to rally. ASSATEAGUE stalked the pace on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and gave way. GLINDA THE GOOD bumped with a rival at the start, settled towards the rear while under some urging, went three then four wide on the turn, dropped inward in upper stretch, came under left hand urging and failed to threaten. FONTANNE was bumped lightly in the hindquarters at the start, settled just off the pace on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the turn and came up empty. CORAL GLADE came out at the start, bumped with DIXIE DARLING then was pulled off that foe by the rider, showed good speed, disputed the pace on the inside, dropped out outside the quarter-pole and faded. (Rail at 12 Feet)
