Footnotes

SPORTSWRITER raced along the outside, was placed in the three path by the five-sixteenths pole and put to encouragement, displayed greenness throughout the stretch drive in reaction to the whip, felt the stick for the initial time left handed and drifted outward a couple of paths, continued to close in with good energy nonetheless, had the rider switch the stick to the opposite side, lugged inward in several stages after being put to a steady diet, yet gained ground despite all the antics, overhauled a badly drifting LITTLE DALE in deep stretch to prove best. LITTLE DALE got off to an alert start, grabbed the lead away from a couple of more energetically handled opponents, showed sharp speed from the two path, with another twosome in hot pursuit, turned for home and was let out coming to the three-sixteenths pole, was still the clear leader with an eighth to go, began to drift outward badly departing that station, got overtaken late and had to settle for the place. ADRIATIC SPIRIT tracked the pacesetter taking the inside route, with full clearance along the rail available all the while, got called upon entering the stretch drive, held his ground resolutely to the end to earn the show. MISSISSIPPI DUEL saved ground, was under light hand encouragement during the run around the bend, had a good belatedly kick to garner the last major slice of the pot. THEWIZARDOFNASSAU gave chase towards the two path, was already under urging turning for home, lacked the necessary response. SKORTON got out hustled by the runner up for early command, pressed that rival from the three path, still being asked for some run as the front pair made their way forward on the turn, backed away after leaving the eighth pole. PARTY IN THE SUN raced along the outside and was no factor. SYNTHESIZER underwent a four wide pursuit and folded. FREUDIAN THERAPIST behaved skittish during the loading procedure, flipping off the pilot and buck jumping, proceeded to come away in good order, took up position in midpack from the two path, was asked for a response late on the turn, came up empty. AUDACIOUS DIXIE forwardly placed after the start, appeared rank, fighting viciously on the left side of the bit as the rider tried his best to maintain a straight course, got his way, bearing outward upon

reaching the turn, losing ground as a result, continued well off the inside thereafter, raced greenly down the lane, as he bobbed and weaved his way to the finish line.
