OUR MISTER came out at the start then bumped ROCKIN BOOGIE, hesitated when the aforementioned rival lost his rider, showed good speed while under a drive, lost the lead to LOUD PIPES midway down the backstretch, chased inside on the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch, drew alongside the leader while under strong hand urging, gained the advantage outside the sixteenth-pole, was given a few successive taps of a down-turned whip inside the sixteenth and proved best while eased up in the final strides. LOUD PIPES came away well, was carried out extremely badly by the loose horse early, went from approximately the five path to at least the thirteen path, allowed the loose horse to clear him, angled to the inside then rushed to the lead, moved clear leaving the backstretch, controlled the action while three then two wide on the turn, drifted out nearing the furlong marker, was put to a right-handed whip while doing so, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished in a very good effort. TRICKY SLAM hit the gate at the start, chased the pace, raced off the heels of LOUD PIPES near the half-mile pole, was hard ridden while two to three wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, pursued the leader while still under right hand encouragement in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip passing the furlong marker, shied inward when switched back to right-handed whip late and weakened while well clear for the show. FROTHY MARKET hesitated at the start, broke a bit slow, dropped well behind while hard ridden and showed little. ROCKIN BOOGIE appeared to have the rider slip out of his right iron at the start, was bumped by OUR MISTER just after the start and unseated the rider. Following a stewards' inquiry into the incident after the start, there was no change made to the order of finish.
