**Footnotes**

SKYFALL was grabbed hold after coming in a step at the start, was guided over towards the middle of the strip down the backstretch in two stages, both times taking the runner up along for a short ride, departed the half mile pole from the four path and remained in it during the run around the bend, got called upon entering the stretch, closed in, continued onward with good momentum to wrest away the lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole just as TAP TWENTY ONE was revving up with her best speed down along the fence, dug in with good determination to fend that opponent off for the decision. TAP TWENTY ONE came away with no apparent mishap, was put to a hold and twice taken outward as the top one was maneuvering her way into the four path, chose a path closer to the rail once that ended, sat unhurried two wide on the turn, was angled outward near but not quite in the four path, was allowed to drift back slightly inward, just in time to have a momentarily open lane shut down, came inward slightly more, with the same result, a shut down lane, idled behind the front runners before ducking over to a clear passageway along the inside, was given some encouragement once settled down there and instantly picked up interest, brushed the rail a stride before reaching the sixteenth pole, regained her best action in short order, but lacked what was needed late to go by the winner. ANITA CHICA was sent over to the rail coming to the end of the backstretch, took the inside route around the turn, was put to a full drive prior to cutting the corner into the lane, confronted the leader at that time with a full head of steam, poked a head down in front at the furlong marker, had it taken away by the top one a sixteenth down the road, weakening eventually into the show slot. PINK TRAFFIC came out running and secured the top, was sent over to rail, came under strong pressure from the left flank getting challenged by a fully driven ANITA CHICA approaching the head of the stretch, put up some fight before yielding at the furlong marker, weakened steadily thereafter. SUMMER OF FUN chased three wide and folded. DOUBLE TAPPED assumed a forward position soon after the start, pressed the issue from the two path, pulling on the left side of the bit for nearly the entire opening quarter pole, needed some urging to keep pace by the five-sixteenths pole, tired after turning for home. ARTFULLY three wide at the half mile pole, trailed throughout.
