THERMAL CAT was hustled from the start then well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, was put to a vigorous hand ride, rallied outside in the final furlong and closed strongly to get up at the wire. CAJUN BREEZE was away well from the outside post, tracked the pacesetting duo while on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn, inched closer coming to the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip after straightening for the drive, switched to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead entering the final furlong, battled with ASCAUGA into the final sixteenth, got the best of that rival but was denied at the wire. ASCAUGA bumped with PROFESSOR FATE at the start, showed good natural speed, disputed the pace on the outside while under his own courage, vied three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail outside the quarter-pole, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled with CAJUN BREEZE while under a left-handed whip, dueled with that rival into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the show. PROFESSOR FATE bumped with ASCAUGA at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced three then four wide on the turn and failed to rally. BIG BLUE NATION dropped back while beaten for speed, was ridden along at the rear, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. ONE SOCK DOWN contested the pace on the inside of ASCAUGA while off the rail, dropped to the inside near the three-eighths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and gave way.
