DANCING FOR GLORY became rank nearing the first turn, continued very rank while off heels on the first turn, was reserved towards the rear while more settled on the backstretch, raced inside early on the far turn, angled three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to four wide while under a drive at the quarter-pole, was asked for her best in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well into the final sixteenth, gained the lead while drifting in a bit and narrowly prevailed then was unsaddled on the backstretch and vanned off. EDDY GOURMET moved in behind opponents early, was rank nearing the first turn, saved ground on that bend, was reserved along the rail, moved up with a half-mile to run, drafted behind the leader while inside on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, made a rail bid near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final sixteenth under a right-handed whip but was caught. RED HOT TWEET was eager into the first turn, raced three wide while hard held on that bend, continued hard held while outside on the backstretch, was given free rein while four to five wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, gained between rivals into the final sixteenth and finished with good courage for the show. DATTTS DA BOSS saved ground on the first turn, settled the mostly kindly of all the runners, was urged along leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn, came under drive while just inside of RED HOT TWEET in upper stretch, steadied off heels outside the furlong marker, regained momentum after passing that marker and finished willingly but lost her best chance. SMITTENWITHKITTEN spun into the first turn with the dust flying, was a bit eager while four wide on that bend, pulled her way to the lead onto the backstretch, set the pace through moderate fractions, brushed with a rival leaving the backstretch, vied off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled until just outside the sixteenth-pole then was outfinished. BLOSSOM'S TRAIL was taken in hand early, raced off the rail on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, drifted out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, held a slim advantage into the final furlong, was switched to a right-handed whip and outkicked. ELUSIVE DESIGN was last away, raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged at the rear, entered the far turn in the two path, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to three wide before the quarter-pole, came out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted back in and failed to threaten. EXCHANGE CAT was taken in hand while contesting the early lead on the inside, raced just behind the pacesetter while under restraint on the backstretch, moved out outside the half-mile pole,

brushed with rivals while between horses into the far turn, raced under intermittent urging while behind foes on that bend, chased in upper stretch and came up empty. (Rail at 9 Feet)
