Non-winners of a Graded stakes allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 or \$30,000 twice since October 1, 5 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 7 lbs.; two races other than maiden or claiming, 9 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 24, 1999 with 24 nominations.

SUCCESSFUL APPEAL, away in good order and close up outside while in hand, advanced three wide approaching the stretch, reached the front in midstretch and drew clear under a strong hand ride. LION HEARTED, unhurried inside, angled out and rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely from the outside. SILVER SEASON, close up inside on the backstretch, dropped back a bit on the turn then came again gamely along the rail in the stretch. TORRID SAND, away awkwardly, raced four wide and finished with good interest from the outside. ARISTOTLE was hustled from the gate, chased the pace from the outside and lacked a solid finishing punch. SHADOW CASTER contested the pace along the inside and tired leaving the furlong grounds. DAVEY'S CUTLASS was off in a tangle and raced inside. FANTASTIC FINISH raced close up outside while well in hand and had no response when roused. TEXAS GLITTER contested the pace from the outside and stopped in the final furlong.
