EVENING ATTIRE hit the gate at the start, was bumped after the start, rallied five wide approaching the stretch, dug in gamely in the drive and was up in the final strides, driving. THIS FLEET IS DUE contested the pace while four wide, earned a short lead nearing the stretch and fought it out gamely to the finish, just missing. WENDOVER put in a six wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. EARLY contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. INDYGO SHINER raced greenly outside, was wide throughout and had no impact on the outcome. BROAD INITIATIVE raced inside and had no rally. DEPUTY DARE raced wide and tired. FORD'S CREEK had no rally. LIFT UP contested the pace along the inside and tired. FENCING MASTER contested the pace while between rivals and tired. NETWORKING contested the pace and tired in the stretch.
