QUIET MIKE was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn, finished determinedly from the outside and was along late, driving. DECADE was hustled along outside, contested the pace while three wide and dug in gamely through the stretch. WILD BLADE raced close up inside early, angled out in the stretch and finished gamely. FAMOUS AGAIN raced four wide and was in tight quarters between rivals in the stretch. STORM DAY raced inside and had no rally. BIEN LUCIDO (CHI) contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. RENOIR contested the pace while four wide and was caught in tight quarters while between rivals in the stretch. LUSH chased the pace while between rivals and tired. LAWYER ADAM came wide for the drive and had no rally. DARWIN contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
