LEMON DROP KID raced close up behind the pacesetters while in hand, angled out and advanced four wide on the second turn, drew clear when roused in upper stretch and remained safely clear under a steady drive. CAT THIEF showed good speed from the outside, came in front of RUNNING STAG on the first turn, argued the pace while between rivals, gained a slim lead midway on the turn, stayed with the winner along the inside into midstretch, altered course to the outside leaving the furlong pole and continued on gamely to earn the place prize. BEHRENS clipped the heels of GOLDEN MISSILE and stumbled when in tight quarters soon after the start, recovered quickly, moved up wide on the first turn, raced close up outside on the backstretch, chased the winner while five wide on the second turn and tired in the stretch. RUNNING STAG was taken in hand after coming away in good order, steadied hard as CAT THIEF dropped over in front of him on the first turn, steadied again while between rivals approaching the backstretch, saved ground for six furlongs, angled out and came wide approaching the stretch then lacked a solid finishing kick. GOLDEN MISSILE moved up quickly from the outside on the first turn, contested the pace while three wide to the far turn then steadily tired thereafter. DAVID quickly showed in front, contested the pace along the inside and gave way after three quarters.
