Footnotes

TEMECULA CREEK rushed up after breaking a bit slowly, raced up close while three wide to the top of the stretch, lugged in while racing greenly after taking the lead inside the furlong marker then edged clear under left hand urging. DE LUCIA steadied after being pinched back at the start, trailed early, swung four wide to launch his bid at the quarter pole then rallied belatedly. WOLLASTON BAY broke inward causing crowding the the start, chased the winner along the inside for a half then closed late between horses to gain a share. ELUSIVE VALUE broke outward at the start, rushed up along the rail, opened a wide gap on the turn, led into midstretch then gave way. TREASURE HUNTER was outrun after breaking slowly, saved ground to the turn, angled out for room nearing the eighth pole and lacked a strong closing bid. GOWDEN MILE steadied after being pinched back at the start and was never close thereafter.
