Footnotes

DANCY'S ANGEL saved ground early, angled between horses at the half mile pole, moved out while rallying on the turn then closed strongly between horses to get up in the final stride. CLASSIC EXPRESSION sprinted clear early, set the pace along the rail into the stretch, dug in when challenged in midstretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. KEEN LASSIE was rated between horses along the backstretch, moved three wide on the far turn, swung five wide to launch her bid at the quarter pole then finished strongly in the middle of the track. CRISPY LIGHTS pressed the pace in the two path for five furlongs, made a run to challenge on the turn, fought heads apart into midstretch and yielded late. THE END IS CLEAR moved up three wide on the first turn, stalked from outside along the backstretch, remained a factor while continuing three wide on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. WINLOC'S HAIL MARY steadied sharply and stumbled along the inside on the first turn, raced in traffic along the rail down the backstretch, saved ground to the turn and lacked a further response. EXTRA IMPACT checked at the start and was shuffled back, was never a factor while six wide on the turn. SKEETER GIRL never reached contention while saving ground. PRIME HONOR broke down on the first turn and was vanned off.
