REMARKABLE NEWS (VEN) sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the front while saving ground for six furlongs, extended his lead in upper stretch, drifted out in midstretch and edged away under steady right hand urging. ASHKAL WAY (IRE) was taken in hand early, raced just behind the leaders along the backstretch, swung out to launch his bid on the far turn, circled four wide entering the stretch, gained a bit in upper stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. DIAMOND GREEN (FR) raced in close contention along the inside, saved ground to the turn, angled between horses entering the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. ARTIE SCHILLER settled just off the early pace, stalked the leaders in the two path for six furlongs, edged closer between horses on the turn, checked and altered course between horses in upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. NOBLE CAUSEWAY was eased back in the early stages then trailed throughout.
