LAW ENFORCEMENT raced back back in hand on the backstretch, circled five wide while closing the gap at the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track under strong encouragement to win going away. DRIVEN BY SUCCESS set a rapid pace while being pressured to the top of the stretch, extended his advantage in midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. FEROCIOUS FIRES was in hand early while just behind the leaders, swung three wide on the turn and finished evenly. PREMIUM WINE raced in good position along the inside for a half and lacked a strong closing response. DR. W stumbled soon after the start, rushed up from outside, pressed a fast pace to the top of the stretch and gave way.
