STRONG IMPACT settled in good position, rallied four wide leaving the turn then closed steadily to get up in the final seventy yards. PAUL'S ACE stalked three wide for a half, made a run to threaten in midstretch then closed late between horses to narrowly gain the place. CITY SNEAKERS raced up close along the rail, made a run to challenge in midstretch, gained a brief lead a sixteenth out and yielded grudgingly. SEPARATIST was outrun after breaking slowly, gained between horses in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. LYKE A HURRICANE set the pace on the rail into midstretch and tired. KARAKORUM TORNADO failed to mount a serious rally while four wide. LIVING FOR THIS saved ground to no avail. DOUBLE DOMINO trailed throughout.
